#### Description

- Scrollbar in Property View partially eclipses property values / buttons
- Some EditorPluginBase methods in QML are failing with exceptions:
  - removeOutputPin()
    - Seems to remove the pin, but throws an exception (either "Cannot read property 'success' of undefined" or "Type error") as well. Seems to also occur when executing ADTFDAT Player's context menu entry, as at most only one pin is removed with every execution.
    - Workaround is currently to ignore this exception and continue.
  - removeInputPin()
    - Same as removeOutputPin()
  - findService()
    - Throws exception "modelmanagerData is not defined".
    - Workaround is currently to access modelmanager.system.service to find a service.
