We tried also =0, =X0, ="x0", ="X0", and also 8 instead of zero, but ADTF does not set properly the speed (remains x1). Can you please let me know what is the correct syntax?</p> <p>Entire command line:</p> <pre>"%ADTF2_DIR%\bin\adtf_launcher.exe" "%WD%\config\adtf_devenv.manifest" -globals="%WD%\config\globals.xml" -config="%WD%\config\system.xml" -active="Converter" -run -playlist="playlist.datpls" -speed="X0" -quit -nosplash</pre> <p>btw - is it possible to pass a single file, instead of a playlist?</p>

leave out -playlist="", so -speed works correctly.
